



Beachcombers Topic Homework Grid



What is a habitat and a micro-habitat? What coastal habitats and micro-habitats are there? What is special about them? Which animals live in them and how are they adapted to suit these habitats?

Draw or paint a picture of the beach. Use your imagination. What might you find there?

Write a story or a poem about the beach. Try to create a picture with words. What can you see, hear, smell or feel? You could think of the story of The Storm Whale. Imagine finding something different washed up on the beach. What would happen?

List the five oceans of the world and the seas that surround the United Kingdom. Write a fact about each of these bodies of water. It might be the location, the size, the temperature or some other interesting fact. Challenge yourself to memorise the facts.

Create a poster to warn people of the dangers of pollution to the creatures of the sea and shore.

Choose a water animal and do some research. What facts can you find? Create a fact sheet or non-chronological report on it. Is it a fish, mammal, reptile, amphibian or bird? Is it a carnivore, herbivore or omnivore? What does it eat? What does it look like? How does it move?
