Throw-Back Thursdays

Research (Willigham, Didau, McCrea) tells us that we remember that which we attach importance to and that which we are asked to recall. School refers to this as powerful knowledge. Low-stakes tasks on Throw-Back Thursdays ensure our pupils recall knowledge from throughout their school career so that it is committed to long term memory and our pupils can retrieve it.

Knowledge Organisers

state the primary 'powerful knowledge', technical (Tier 3) vocabulary that should be retained over time.

Stimuli for topic is built upon a combination of pupil needs and interests, Christian Teachings, the locality, National Curriculum and Cornerstones
