

Dates for your diary and other information.....

Monday 27th January—Holocaust Memorial Day—Y5/6—In commemoration, Our Y5/6 children will be contributing to an art installation for the Hartlepool Art Gallery.

Tuesday 4th February—Balance Bikes—EYFS—The balance bike programme is delivered by Hartlepool Cycle Clinic team from Summerhill. EYFS children will take part in a half hour session during the school term and this will run over 3 weeks.

Wednesday 5th February—Chinese New Year—EYFS—The children will take part in several activities including retelling the story of Chinese New Year, creating and making lanterns, learning about the Chinese culture and how New Year is celebrated.

Fridays 10am-11am w/c 10th February-27th April—Swimming—Y3/4—Children will need a full bodied swimming costume for girls and fitted swimming trunks for boys (no bikinis or loose-fitting swimming shorts), a swimming cap as children cannot swim without one and a towel.

Tuesday 11th February—Church Service—KS2—Each term, our KS2 children will be attending worship at St Peters Church. They will return to school before the end of the day. Children will need to bring a change of footwear for the walk to church.
