

Dear Parents/Carers

As you know, we are constantly striving to provide our pupils with high quality, engaging experiences in a wide variety of disciplines which enable the children to decide what they enjoy and develop their hidden talents and this term is no exception!

The Year 5 /6 pupil had the exciting to opportunity to watch a live streamed production of the Macbeth performed by the Royal Shakespeare Company. Our children were also able to take part in workshops via the 'live link' with the actual cast and director. Mrs Wilson is extremely proud of fantastic quality of the writing that this performance has inspired.

In the world of STEM, our pupils have had lots of exciting opportunities this term. Our Year 5 and 6 pupils also participated in live STEM chats with Nick Valentine a Robotics' Engineer for the Ministry of Defence. Year 4 and Year 5 pupils have thoroughly enjoyed 'hip hop' classes from Ruff Diamonds and have certainly impressed our guest dancers. Biennially, our Year 3 and Year 4 pupils, have the opportunity to attend the 3 day residential at the magnificent, Ford Castle in Berwick-upon-Tweed. They have participated in lots of fun filled activities and their independent skills have developed.

On March 11th, the Year 5 and Year 6 pupils of St Peter's Elwick and Hart Primary School had the amazing privilege of meeting and listening to the personal story of 93 year Gabriele Keeneghan - a Holocaust survivor. There are very few survivors still alive to tell their personal story and her tale stressed to the children the difference a small act of kindness can make and we hope that this will encourage our children to continue to be kind, understanding, courageous advocates.

St Peter's Elwick received a congratulatory letter from Rt Hon Nick Gibb (Minister of State for School Standards) thanking school for our commitment to continuing to drive towards higher academic standards and for our children's achievement in mathematics is in the top 2% of primary schools in the country.
