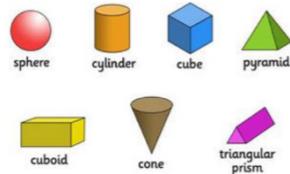
Sharing – to solve problems involving sharing. Shares by 'dealing out' equally between two or more recipients.
