

Symptomatic Pupils and Positive Cases

Any children showing symptoms of COVID should book an appointment for a PCR test immediately and must NOT come onto the school premises. School cannot accept a lateral flow test results for children. Thank you for support.

St Peter's, Elwick School has followed Government guidance and will close for the Easter Holidays.

We are committed to continue to work into the Easter holidays in order to receive notification of any positive test results that may impact upon the pupils and staff in our schools, in order to support our communities. We therefore ask that if your child develops symptoms and receives a positive Covid result that you follow the guidelines below.

1) If a child develops symptoms within 48 hours of last being in school AND they test positive,

please email the school on the info email address below.

2) If a child is taken for a test without symptoms and they test positive AND they were in school 48 hours or less before they were taken for a test, then please email the school on the info email address below. Only your school's email address; info.elwick@nllt.co.uk

If a child shows symptoms 48 hours after being in school and tests positive, or your child has no

symptoms but has a test more than 48 hours after finishing school on the 26th March December and tests positive, please contact Test and Trace in the usual way. If school are notified of a positive case

That impacts upon anyone in school as a close contact, an email will be sent to parents to notify them. Please ensure that you check your email inbox

We also ask that parents inform school via info.elwick@nllt.co.uk of any other positive tests that take place in the holidays that will impact on the return of a pupil on 12th April 2021

Your Child's Learning for Summer Term

Assessments have taken place and we will strive to ensure that any gaps in learning are filled whether by bespoke provision in the classroom or sessions beyond the school day. If we are able to provide sessions beyond the school day . your child's class teacher will contact you directly discuss the aim and purpose of the session.
