First Response Procedure - Child Absence from school

If a child is not in attendance at school for any reason, parents/carers must inform the school by telephone 01429 274904 /01429 273283 or email to info.elwick@nllt.co.uk / info.hart@nllt.co.uk on the first day of absence by 9.30am. If the school does not receive any reason for absence by this time a phone call will be made to the first contact held for the child to establish the reason for absence. If no answer is received then further contacts held for the child will be tried until we receive a response. If school do not receive an answer that reassures staff that the pupil is safe then the Head Teacher will be informed and members of staff will visit the family home before lunchtime. If no answer is received at the property, then the police will be contacted and concerns raised with the Local Authority. We understand that this may seem extreme, however, we have a duty of care to ensure that all of our children are safe. If you have any queries regarding this procedure, please contact the school office.

COVID Symptomatic Pupils and Positive Cases

Any children showing symptoms of COVID should book an appointment for a PCR test immediately and must NOT come onto the school premises. School cannot accept a lateral flow test results for children.

We ask parents to continue to wear face masks when they enter the premises for the protection of staff and pupils. Thank you for support.
