Half Term and COVID Cases

School will continue to work to support Track and Trace over the half term holiday to support our school community.

48 hours of last being in school AND they test positive, please email the school on the info email address below.

If a child is taken for a test without symptoms and they test positive AND they were in school 48 hours or less before they were taken for a test, then please email the school on the info email address below

If a child shows symptoms 48 hours after being in school and tests positive, or your child has no symptoms but has a test more than 48 hours after finishing school on 28th May 2021 and tests positive, please contact Test and Trace in the usual way.

If school are notified of a positive case that impacts upon anyone in school as a close contact, an email will be sent to parents to notify them. Please ensure that you check your email inbox.

Breakfast Club and Pick Up Support

Just a reminder that there are still breakfast club places available. There are two Breakfast Club offers with the aim of supporting parents who need to be at work and those with siblings starting at different times whilst adhering to all preventative measures.

Option 1 Provision from 7:45 to the start of your child's class teaching time. £3

Option 2 Provision from 8:40 to the start of your child's class teaching time. £1

Pick Up Support is also available after school until 3:05/3:15 at a cost of £1.

There is no booking form to complete for Breakfast Club or Pick Up Support – if you are late to collect your children, it will be presumed that you want pick up support and will be charged accordingly. Pick Up support ends at 3.05/3.15.
