School Lunches

From September 2021 the cost of school lunches will be £10.65 per week (£2.13 per day) These charges will only apply to children in Nursery and Key Stage 2 if they stay for a school lunch. Children in Reception and Years 1 and 2 are provided a school meal which is free of charge.

Please be reminded that if you are planning on changing from school meals to packed lunches then we require notification by email to info.elwick@nllt.co.uk during the half term before the changes will take place.

Breakfast Club and Pick Up Support

Just a reminder that there are still breakfast club places available. There are two Breakfast Club offers with the aim of supporting parents who need to be at work and those with siblings starting at different times whilst adhering to all preventative measures.

Option 1 - Provision from 7:45 to the start of your child's class teaching time. £3

Option 2 - Provision from 8:40 to the start of your child's class teaching time. £1

Pick Up Support is also available after school until 3:05/3:15 at a cost of £1.

There is no booking form to complete for Breakfast Club or Pick Up Support – if you are late to collect your children, it will be presumed that you want pick up support and will be charged accordingly. Pick Up support ends at 3.05/3.15.

Y5 and 'Real Ties'

To support out children with their transition to secondary school, St Peter's Elwick gifts our current Year 5 children with a 'real tie'. The purpose of this is so that they learn how to tie a tie before they start their journey in secondary school and it gives them one less thing to worry about it. The Y5 will receive their tie by the end of term. Having gifted the tie, it is our hope that they will wear their tie as part of the uniform expectation. We look forward to seeing them in September.
