Understanding the World

Science – UTW – The Natural World - Beach

Key Vocabulary:

Natural objects such as shells, stones, sand and drift wood is found on the beach.

Driftwood is wood that has been washed onto a beach by the sea.

Animals such as dolphins, sharks and seahorses live in the sea.
