## New Knowledge

We live in England.

Each environment can have different weather, plants and animals.

Some **environments** are different to the one in which we live. Some examples are deserts and jungles.

We can give examples of some **similarities and differences** that we notice in stories, maps and nonfiction texts. (Weather, food, day-to-day life etc). Examples:

South Africa is a much larger **country** than England but the number of people who live in England and South Africa is similar.

It is hotter in South Africa.

South Africa has beaches and mountains like we do in England.
