New knowledge

To keep out of danger in the water you 'Stop and Think and Spot the Dangers.'

There are four flags at the beach to look out for:

The danger flag – which shows where danger is.

The bathing flag- which shows where it is safe to swim in the sea.

The surfing flag- which shows where it is safe for water sports.

The windsock- which shows how windy it is.

These flags all help keep us safe.
