Helpful hints

Quelle est la date de ton anniversaire? Literally translates as What is the date of your birthday?
 “ton” is an informal way of saying “your” for a singular masculine noun.
 “Quelle” is the feminine form of “what” because “date” is a feminine noun.
 “Joyeux” is the masculine form of the adjective meaning “Happy” because anniversaire is a masculine noun.

Did you know ...

In French, we don't capitalise months of the year, unless it's at the beginning of a sentence.

In French, numbers 21 and 31 are *vingt-et-un* and *trente-et-un*.

Other two digit numbers do not have “et” (and)

E.g. 22, 17 = vingt-deux, dix-sept. It is important to remember the hyphen.
