Earlier this week, you received a letter from the Trust describing the revised, proposed dates for the wider provision for prioritised groups as outlined in the Government Guidelines.

Pupils of Critical Workers	Continued
Year 1 Pupils	Monday June 15th
Reception Pupils	Monday June 22 nd
Nursery Pupils	Thursday 25 th June (if capacity allows)

Parents and carers who are critical workers or have a child in Year 1 and Reception have already received the documentation regarding how school will look and function on their child's return to school. For those choosing to return, the teacher assigned to their 'family bubble' will send a video message to welcome the pupils back to school. School will then review provision and determine if we can safely accommodate the return of nursery pupils.

Please note that parents, carers and pupils who are displaying any symptoms of Coronavirus must NOT enter the school premises.

Those children who are not in the prioritised groups listed above will receive a phone call from their class teacher next week. As before, we completely understand if families and pupils are unable to take the call due to varying home situations. Please take the opportunity during this call to ask any questions regarding the Oak Learning. Additional home learning packs will also be sent home.

As mentioned in my last letter you will soon be receiving your child's annual report. A letter will accompany the report explaining its content. The reports will be emailed to each parent separately. To facilitate this, the reports will be sent over a period of weeks so please don't worry if one sibling or child in the class receives their report at a different time.

It is lovely to be able to share with you that Mrs Thompson's son has arrived safe and well. I am sure you will join me in congratulating the Thompson Family on the birth of Barney George Thompson.
