

Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parent / Carer,

It has been another great week in school.

Now that we have numbers for both Breakfast club options, we are in a positon to consider support for parents with the staggered pick-ups. Please note that we cannot allow a high volume of pupils to access this provision as we need to maintain social distancing and we may need to cap numbers. The 'pick-up support' will start from the end of a child's school day and finish at the last 'pick-up' at 3:15.
