

School Lunch Reminder

From September 2021 the cost of school lunches will be £10.65 per week (£2.13 per day) These charges will only apply to children in Nursery, if they stay for lunch, and children in Key Stage 2. Children in Reception and Years 1 and 2 are provided a school meal which is free of charge. Please be reminded that if you are planning on changing from school meals to packed lunches then we require notification by email to info.hart@nllt.co.uk , during the half term before the changes will take pace.
