Y4 Parents and the Multiplication Check

The MTC is **a key stage 2 (KS2) assessment** taken by pupils at the end of year 4. The MTC is focused on the fluent recall of multiplication facts. The MTC is delivered as an online, on-screen digital assessment. The purpose of the test is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently (within 5 seconds), which is essential for future success in mathematics. Miss Pickles and Miss Tillson are holding a meeting via MST for parents/carer on 13th October 1515-1545. All Y4 parents will receive an invite to the meeting via your child's MST account.

Local Trip Consent
