If anyone has had a clear out after Christmas and would like to recycle any clothing, the recycle bins are in the school yard, please feel free to use them.



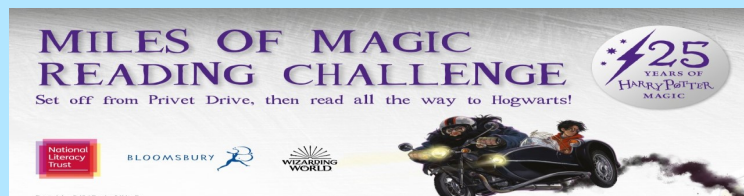
