## Understanding The World

### The Natural World (Science)

#### Key Vocabulary

Salt, fresh, ocean, sea, lakes, reservoirs, ponds, rivers, streams, habitat, animal, coral reef, live, rockpool, oyster, crab, star fish, wrinkle, crab,

#### Key Knowledge

Salt water is found mostly in our oceans and seas.

Fresh water is found in lakes, reservoirs, ponds, rivers and streams.

A habitat is the home of a plant or animal (re-cap).

There are different habitats on the coast such as rockpools and coral reefs.

Coral reefs are underwater and are made up of tiny animals called coral polyps. Oysters and lots of other fish live among the coral reef.

Rockpools are small pools of water between the rocks.

Animals such as wrinkles, fish, star fish and crabs are found in rockpools.

### Geography

Key Vocabulary – Similar, different (re-cap), travel, community, language, country.

#### Key Knowledge-

We live in the United Kingdom/England.

The weather in England is different to other places in the world.

Countries all over the world have foods that are special to them.

Different countries use different money E.g. pounds/pence and euros.

People all over the world speak in different languages E.g. English, French, German, Spanish.

We can use a map to find where we live and to find other places in the world.

### Computing

Key Vocabulary I-pad, Camera, photograph, button, press, app, symbol, videos.

#### Key Knowledge

An I-pad can be used to take photographs.

To take a photograph you need to press the camera button and then move the I-pad to where you need it to be and then press the camera button. You can look at the photographs you have taken by clicking on the camera button.



To watch a video, you need to press the triangle button and you can make it go full screen by pressing the right triangle button.



Religious Education – Stories Jesus told (Lost sheep. Lost coin Lost Son)

Key Vocabulary- Parable, Bible, story, Jesus, loving, forgiving, Christians.

#### Key Knowledge

The stories Jesus told are called parables.

The parables of the lost sheep, the lost coin and the lost son tell us about love and forgiveness.

Forgiveness is to let go of hurt feelings and make a new start.

Jesus is teaching that each person is important to God.

Christians believe God loves each person and keeps looking for them.

### Athletics

#### Key Vocabulary

Athletic, sport, race, run, jump, throw, jog, sprint, bend, knees, safe

#### Key Knowledge

Athletic sports include running, throwing and jumping.

We can run, jog or sprint somewhere.

A sprint is a fast run. You would need to sprint to win a running race.

We can jump to get somewhere.

To jump safely, we need to bend our knees.
